## South Caribbean Championships (SCC) - Selection Policy

### Purpose

The SCC is the brainchild of the TTTAF, Barbados Archery Federation and the other smaller French islands of the Caribbean. The TTTAF hopes to use this event to expose up and coming local archers to a regional level archery event. It is hoped that exposing the younger archers to competition will better prepare them to represent T&T at higher caliber events giving them confidence as well as exposure to the elimination format while away from home.

### Criteria for Selection

Archers in the Cadet and Junior classes will be given first preference, followed by those new\* to the senior and master categories. Archers must also meet criteria 2-5 of the [“National Policy for Consideration for Selection to Represent Trinidad and Tobago at Regional and International Archery Tournaments”](#)

\*Have not represented T&T in a major international event.

### Selection Process

The SCC is comprised of four main events:

- 18M shoot, can be indoor or outdoor.
- FITA (Double distance) with eliminations.
- Field shoot.
- Federal shoot.
- Some host countries also have a SCC Cup shoot at the end to determine the overall winner of the tournament. This event is a team shoot in which the three-person team must comprise one female archer, one compound archer and any other, e.g. 1 Female Compound archer and 2 Male Recurve archer's can make the team.

The tournaments identified below will all fall in the year previous to the year of the SCC event, i.e. using results from 2016 for eligibility in the 2017 SCC.

For these events the top three archers will be assigned points as such: 1<sup>st</sup> – 4pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 3pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 2pts. Positions 4 & 5 will receive 1pt each and will serve the position of alternates.

**Indoor component** – National Open and National Youth Indoor Championships.

**FITA component** - National Open and National Youth Outdoor Championships.

**Field component** - In September of every year a field shoot will be held.

**Federal component** - In October of every year a federal shoot will be held.

**Team component** – Points obtained in this category will be based on the average three arrow score shot by the archer in the elimination events of the Indoor and Outdoor Nationals. Points will be given as such:

- 18 end average and below – 1pt
- 21 end average and below – 2pts
- 24 end average – 3pts
- Above 24 end average – 5pts

The top three archers in each category will be considered for team selection with the other two being considered as alternates. Places on the team will be subject to available spaces and budgetary considerations.

### Announcement of the Team

Archers considered for team selection will be notified by November and will be given until no later than November 30<sup>th</sup> to confirm their attendance.

Members of the TTTAF and its affiliated clubs will be notified via all available means (website, social media, email, etc.) of the team selected, in December.

### Team Training

Team training will begin in December and conclude one week before the team is due to leave. An official selected by the TTTAF will conduct the sessions. Archers will be required to have an attendance percentage of 75%.
