Start time: 8:15am

Format:

Two rounds of 30 arrows, with 3 arrow ends. No eliminations

Inspection starts at 8:15am [if time permits warm-up rounds will be shot until 9:00am]. Shooting starts at 9:00am.

Classes and Faces:

Benjamin and Cub ¹	80cm Face
Cadet, Junior, Senior & Master	40cm Face

Registration

Registration closes on Tuesday 10th January 2017 at 11:00pm. Payment can be made on the day. **Cost is \$20.**

Score Application (i.e. Selection Process)

NB: PARTICIPATION IN THIS EVENT IS MANDATORY FOR THOSE ARCHERS WHO WISH TO SHOOT IN THE NATIONAL INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2017

Scores shot in this event will be used in two ways:

1. To select archers to represent Trinidad and Tobago in the MICA event for 2017.
2. As the ranking round for the National Indoor Championships 2017.

MICA EVENT SELECTION²

PLEASE INDICATE WHEN REGISTERING WHICH YOUTH ARCHER(S) WANT(S) TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OPEN INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS.

Archers for the NYIC 2017 (i.e. youth archers)

- At the end of 60 arrows, Cadet and Junior archers will be ranked by class and sex. The top 14 per category will be selected to represent T&T in the MICA.³

¹ Benjamin and Cub archers are ineligible for the MICA shoot as they do not shoot on 40cm faces.

² Final numbers selected per category is dependent on the number of archers registered.

³ For classes that are unable to field 14 spots the available spaces will be given to the larger categories.

Archers for the NOIC 2017 (open category)

- At the end of 60 arrows, archers will be ranked in the below classes; the top 14 per class will be selected to represent T&T in the MICA.⁴

Classes for the Open event are as follows:

1. Recurve Men – Male recurve archers from Cadet to Master.
2. Recurve Women – Female recurve archers from Cadet to Master.
3. Compound Men – Male compound archers from Cadet to Master.
4. Compound Women – Female compound archers from Cadet to Master.

NATIONAL INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2017 ELIMINATION ROUND SELECTION

The top 32 per category⁵ will move forward (i.e. the round of 16) where applicable.

SELECTION PROCESS FOR NON-RESIDENTS

The TTTAF acknowledges that non-resident archers may be unable to attend this qualifier shoot and has made the following concessions:

1. Archers will be allowed to shoot an 18m score, under supervision of an official and in the stipulated format, between the period of Tuesday 13th December 2016 to Sunday January 15th 2017.
2. **ALL SCORES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY JANUARY 15TH 2017** at 11pm. Late submissions will not be accepted. Applicable formats: scanned copy or digital photograph of the **SIGNED** scoresheet.

Eligibility

All archers must be nationals of Trinidad and Tobago.
