TTTAF NATIONAL RANKING SYSTEM

Purpose

The National Ranking System will be utilized by the TTTAF to select archers for: consideration on the National Team¹, receipt of awards and development programs. It is also meant to provide a source of motivation to archers and increase participation. Rankings will be calculated annually.

National Ranking Tournaments

The Federation would, at the start of each year, announce the tournaments that would be considered as National Ranking Tournaments. The results of these tournaments would be the only results used to calculate the national ranking score.

Classes

All classes and categories will be included in the system, i.e. from Benjamins to Masters.

Calculating the Ranking Score

An archer's ranking will be calculated based on three factors:

- Ranking round placement.
- Elimination round placement.
- Average arrow shot in the ranking round.

These factors will give a holistic picture of the archer's performance at the event. Points will be allocated as such.

Publishing of the Ranking Score

The rankings will be published on the TTTAF website [<http://www.ttarchery.com>].

Format

The format of National Ranking tournaments (excluding the National Indoor and Outdoor Championships) will be standardized as follows:

Preliminary Round:

Double Distance shoot (72 arrows) followed by eliminations.

There will be two rounds of 36 arrows with six (6) ends of six (6) arrows with a short break between. The top four in each category will move forward.

Elimination Round: The top four (4) moves on

Compound: Cumulative Score, 5 sets of 3 arrows.

Recurve: Set system, first to six (6) points, 3 arrow ends.

Distances and classes: All classes are invited.
