## NATIONAL CHAMPION CLUB - RULES & ELIGIBILITY

The T&T Target Archery Federation\_in an effort to both reward participation in and encourage wider participation in our national events proposes the formation of an award which will be known as the National Champion Club of T&T.

This will take the form of a Challenge trophy with the Champion Club being determined based on the results of our two National Championship Tournaments, the Indoor and Outdoor Championships.

The following criterion will apply:

- 1 .The scores as shot in the ranking round will be used for the determination of the Champion Club.
- 2. Determination of the Champion Club will be based on a points system with results taken from the ranking round and the final category elimination positions.
- 3 .In order for an archer to be eligible for the points they must compete in the ranking round. If for any reason they are unable to complete the round, any accumulated score will still be eligible for any available points.
- 4. Each club can enter as many categories as they have candidates to fill.
- 5. Points will be awarded for the first three (3) places in each category for the National Indoor round, 3 for first, 2 for second and 1 for third.. In the National Outdoor round, points will be awarded for the first five(5) positions, 5 for first, 4 for second etc. A single entrant in any category will be eligible for any available points. I.e. no archer/club will be penalized as a result of other archers/clubs being unable to field an archer in a particular class.
- 6. Non nationals of T&T who are members of a club are eligible for participation.
- 7. Nationals who reside abroad (and are members of the Federation) may shoot for any member club as they and the club decide.
- 8. Independent members may select the club they wish to shoot for, but this must be acceptable to the club.
- 9. Classes will be in Male/Female, Compound/Recurve. Seniors, Juniors, Cadets, Benjamins, Masters, Mixed team and Team.
